Saint Petersburg State Forest Technical University invites you to take part in the Pan-Russian conference with international participation ***Dendrobiotic Invertebrates and Fungi and their Role in Forest Ecosystems*** (The Kataev Memorial Readings – XI), which will be held on November 24–27, 2020 at the Department of Forest Protection, Wood Science and Game Management of Saint Petersburg State Forest Technical University (Institutsky per., 5, Saint Petersburg, Russia).
